1. Home Office Deduction

Eligibility: Must exclusively use a home

office space for business.

Deductible: Proportionate share of mortgage, rent, utilities, and repairs.

2. Travel Expenses Deductible Items:

Airfare, train tickets, or car rentals Meals and lodging Local transportation (taxi, rideshare services

3. Education and Training Eligible Expenses:

Certification costs (e.g., CISSP, CISM) Training courses and workshops Professional conferences and seminars

4. Professional Services Include:

Legal and accounting fees Consulting service

5. Office Supplies and Equipment Deductible:

Computers, software, and peripherals Office supplies like paper, pens, and printer toner

6. Communication Expenses Includes:

Internet and phone bills Mobile devices used for business

7. Professional Dues and Subscriptions Eligible:

Membership fees for professional organizations Subscriptions to industry journals and publications

8. Insurance Types:

Business insurance (liability, professional indemnity)
Health insurance if self-employed

9. Marketing and Advertising Deductible:

Website development and hosting costs
Online advertising (e.g., Google Ads)

10. Miscellaneous Other possible deductions:

Bank fees related to business accounts

Depreciation on equipment and assets
